#### Storage and Disposal

#### PRECAUTIONS for treated seed

OPERATORS MUST WEAR SUITABLE PROTECTIVE CLOTHING (COVERALLS) AND SUITABLE

PROTECTIVE GLOVES when handling treated seed or contaminated seed sowing equipment.

DO NOT HANDLE seed unnecessarily DO NOT USE TREATED SEED as food or feed

KEEP TREATED SEED SECURE from people, domestic stock/pets and wildlife at all times during storage and use

The active substances in the product are: fluopicolide a pyridinylmethyl-benzamides fungicide, and fluoxastrobin a strobilurin (QoI) fungicide.

Scenic Gold is a seed treatment for autumn and spring sown crops of oilseed rape for the control of seed borne and early foliar attacks of leaf spot (*Phoma lingam*), downy mildew (*Peronospora parasitica*), *Alternaria brassicae* and *A. brassicicola* and gives a reduction in 'damping - off' symptoms caused by soil borne *Rhizoctonia solani*.

#### DISEASES CONTROLLED

##### Leaf spot (*Phoma lingam*)

Control of seed borne and early foliar attacks of Phoma on the cotyledons and young leaves.

##### Downy mildew (*Peronospora parasitica*)

Control of early foliar attacks of downy mildew on the cotyledons and young leaves.

##### Stem browning symptoms (*Alternaria spp.*)

Control of stem base browning symptoms caused by *Alternaria brassicae* and *A. brassicicola*.

#### 'Damping-off'

Reduction in 'damping-off' symptoms caused by soil borne *Rhizoctonia solani*.

#### CROP SPECIFIC INFORMATION

Scenic Gold may be used on all varieties of autumn and spring sown oilseed rape seed.

#### APPLICATION

1.0 Litre per 100 kilogram of seed.

Scenic Gold must only be used in conjunction with Bayer CropScience approved seed treatment application equipment by following the procedures given in the operating instructions. ALWAYS follow the operating instructions.

Scenic Gold should be evenly applied using a seed treatment machine which has been carefully calibrated to ensure the correct dose rate is applied. Use the product undiluted.

Ensure that Scenic Gold is homogeneous before use. Where necessary, the product should be fully re-dispersed using a re-circulating pump or mechanical agitator.

After use the product application equipment should be thoroughly cleaned using clean water.

Treated seed should be allowed to dry before being packaged – the subsequent

application of talc or other drying powders (1-2 kg per 100 kg seed) can assist the drying process of treated seed.

Scenic Gold seed treatment should not be used on seed with more than 9% moisture content, on sprouted seed or on cracked, split or otherwise damaged seed.

Seed treated with Scenic Gold must be drilled (not broadcast) and kept in a cool dry draught-free place until use.

#### TIMING OF SEED STORAGE

Use treated seed within 18 months of treatment.

#### RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT

Use of this product should form part of a resistance management strategy. Consult the FRAG website for further information
