Restrictions

- Al. ... min. num of 5 days between applications
 Do not allow packs to become wet during sorage
- Do not keep opened picks flom one season to a other
- Only apply Of the Lin Lank-mixture with other fungicide.

Disease Control

OPTION contains cymoxanil, which is locally s 'stem'. It should be used as part of a season long programme of correctly timed sprays commencing before blight infection. Control of late blight of potatoes caused by Phytophthora infestans is achieved when OPTION is used in conjunction with products containing active substances with multi-site activity. OPTION should only applied in tank-mixture with other fungicides containing a different active ingredient e.g. fluazinam (see COMPATIBILITY). The combination of active ingredients will also help to reduce the selection and build-up of resistant strains of fungi. Potato fungicides may not give complete protection of blight when the incidence of the disease is severe. A strategy for preventing

and managing resistance should be adopted. The Fungicide Resistance Action Committee (FRAC) have produced guidelines and copies are available from your distributor, crop advisor or product manufacturer.

Grops

OPTION can be used on all varieties of early and in linear notatoes. On crops grown for processing consult your processor before use.

iming of spray applications should take into account the prevalent of the disease in the area and if conditions sur port disease spread. The first spray shoul be a poiled as soon as there is a risk of blight infection or an official warning has been issucd. In the absence of a warning, spraying should be gin just before the crop meets along the remaining. Applications should be repeated at 10-, 4 day intervals depending on the prevalence of the disease and favourable conditions for infection. A 5 day spray interval may be used under exceptional circumstances e.g. blight risk is already high and rain is forecast at the time of the next 10 day spray is due. High risk situations include conditions of rapid growth, irrigated crops, areas of intensive potato growing, particularly blight-sensitive varieties, when further warnings are issued, or when active blight is in the area. The longer interval is recommended under dry conditions. Irrigation of crops increases the risk of blight and crops should always be sprayed

with OPTION as soon as possible after irrigation subject to the minimum spray interval. Irrigated crops should normally be sprayed at 10 day intervals.

Volume and application

Apply OPTION in 200 litres of water per hectare using a N-FDIUM quality spray (as defined by BCF). Wight water volumes may be used in inck of dense crops to improve coverage.

Dos

Apply OPTION at U. 5 kg/lia in tank-mixture with another plug of recommended for control of potato blight on aning a fungicide from a different cross resistance group and is applied at a dose that will give robust control. All other requirements and restrictions on the partner product label(s) should be adhered to.

Resistance

When fungicides with the same mode of action are used repeatedly over several years in the same field, naturally occurring less sensitive strains may survive, propagate and become dominant in that field. It is therefore advised that wherever possible spray programmes should include fungicides with differing modes of action. Please refer to Fungicide Resistance Action Group guidelines for further details.

Mixing

Spraying equipment should be thoroughly cleaned

before spraying. OPTION mixes easily with water and should be added directly to the spray tank during filling. Wash out container and add washings to the spray tank. Continue agitation until spraying is complete.
