# **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Emerger is a diphenylether preceme gence perbicide for the control of annual broad-leaved weeds and some grass weeds in proatoes, power and beans.

Emerger is used pre-emerger e of the crops. The surface of the soil should be evenly covered with the product, where its actives usefunce (aclonifen) forms an even film. Clumps on the surface of the soil significantly refuse the effectiveness on the product. To achieve the greatest effect the soil and furrows must be well orepared and spile, at with the herbicide appropriately. Emerger gets into weeds through the product of the construction of weeds, but it anects prouting weeds it a certain extent, which depends on the internal resources of the second, speed or growth of the weeds and volume of absorbed active substance. Typical symptoms of the Emerger effect are as follows: intensive colours and chlorosis appear on the tissues of young, emerging spillurs and shoots. Later, weeds stop growing and perish. Emerger does not get into plants this bug if their roots, so it is not absolutely dependent on soil moisture and temperature at the time of its uilegater.

After pre-emergence application do not disrupt the herbicide layer. Any form of mechanical cultivation or disruption of the soil surface by any other method will reduce the level of weed control provided.

Follow normal drilling / planting and ensure the seed is well covered.

#### RESTRICTIONS

DO NOT disrupt the soil surface after application as this will reduce the level weed control provided. To prevent damage, extreme care must be taken to avoid spray drift onto neighbouring crops.

#### HERBICIDE RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT

When herbicides with the same mode of action are used repeatedly over several years in the same field, selection of resistant biotypes can take place. These can propagate and may become dominating. A weed species is considered to be resistant to a herbicide if it survives a correctly-applied treatment at the recommended dose. A strategy for preventing and managing such resistance should be adopted. This should include integrating herbicides with a programme of cultural control measures. Guidelines have been produced by the Weed Resistance Action Group and copies are available from Teagasc, your distributor, crop adviser or product manufacturer.

#### WEEDS CONTROLLED

Emerger is absorbed primarily through the shoot of emerging seedlings at they grow through the layer of herbicide applied pre-emergence to the soil surface. Susceptibly weeds can emerge, but these will become chlorotic, their growth will be retarded leading ultimately to death. After pre-emergence application do not disrupt the herbicide layer. Any form of mechanical cultivation or disruption of the soil surface by any other method will reduce the level of weed control provided.

# FOLLOWING CROPS and CROP FAILURE

There are no restrictions on following crops in the normal rotation, provided the soil is cultivated to a depth of 10 cm before sowing.

In the event of crop failure for any reason, spring and winter oilseed rape, spring and winter barley, spring and winter wheat, spring and winter triticale, rye, sugar beet, white mustard, sunflower, maize, peas, beans or soya beans may be sown 3 weeks after using Emerger, provided the soil is cultivated to a depth of 10 cm before sowing.

## MIXING

Shake the container well before use. Half fill the spray tank with clean water, begin agitation and add the required amount of Emerger. Wash out the container and add the washings to the spray solution, before topping up with clean water. Continue agitation until spraying is completed. Do not leave the sprayer filled with the spray solution standing for long periods. Wash out the sprayer thoroughly after use, using a wetting agent or proprietary tank cleaner.

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
