





- Industrial chemicals
- Professional use chemicals

- Mixtures, e.g., glues, oven cleaners, sealants
- Articles, e.g. jewellery, leather goods

- Biocides (DAFM)
- Pesticides (DAFM)
- Cosmetics (HPRA)
- Medicines (HPRA)
- Veterinary products (HPRA)
- Waste (DECC/EPA)



What we check



- REACH checks include:
 - ✓ registration status of substances on own or in mixtures
 - ✓ presence of banned/restricted or chemicals
 - ✓ Safety Data Sheets/ Exposure Scenario's
- CLP checks include:
 - ✓ Classification, Labelling, Packaging
 - ✓ Unique Formula Identifier notification to Poison Centre
 - ✓ C&L inventory- notification status of substances on own or in mixtures
- Detergents checks include:
 - ✓ information requirements
 - ✓ labelling



How we carry out the checks



Proactively:

- Inspections and audits
- Desktop assessments incl. online checks
- National & EU campaigns/projects (consumer/professional/industrial focuses)

Reactively through follow up on:

- Referrals internally & from other Irish/EU authorities
- Complaints
- Safety Gate (RAPEX) alerts
- Referrals from other Member States via ICSMS



Export Import (PIC) Regulation



- PIC Regulation (<u>EU No 649/2012</u>) implements the <u>Rotterdam Convention</u> in the EU.
- Chemicals Act 2008 & 2010: Administration and enforcement in Ireland
 - HSA: DNA for industrial products
 - DAFM: DNA for pesticides
- COM Meetings: Bi-annually attended by HSA and DAFM alternatively
- ECHA ePIC tool used by DNA for processing import and export notifications
- ECHA FORUM for exchange for enforcement includes PIC
- National coordination of Article 10 and 22 reporting
- Export & Import of Dangerous Chemicals Health and Safety Authority
- Understanding PIC ECHA

EU REF 13 project on online sales



- REF 13 obligations related to online sale of products
- Includes substances, mixtures and articles
- Operational during 2025
- HSA and EPA participating
- EPA National Coordinator
 - REACH restrictions
 - CLP labelling and packaging, advertising
 - POPs
 - RoHS (voluntary)

The Forum for Exchange of Information on Enforcement



An tÚdarás Sláinte agus Sábháilteachta Health and Safety Authority

- Network of authorities responsible for the enforcement of REACH, CLP, PIC, POP and BPR Regulations in the EU, Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein:
- Aims:
 - Contributing to harmonised enforcement of these Regulations.
 - Mandated to identify best practice in enforcement and develop tools of use to local inspectors

FORUM POW

- Work Programme of the Forum 2024-2025
- Coordinates REF projects, (REACH and CLP), BEF projects (on Biocides), pilot projects, training and acts as ADCO for Chemicals under Market Surveillance Regulation
- Gives enforcement advice on new restrictions as per REACH Article 77(4) and 68(2)
- Train the trainer events held each year closely aligned with next REF project (next one in Nov 25 on REF 14 on CLP)



EU Product Compliance Network



- Aims to structure the coordination and cooperation between market surveillance authorities in EU countries
- Streamline market surveillance practices within the EU
- Facilitate the implementation of joint enforcement activities by member state authorities
- Maintains a communication and information system between EU countries (ICSMS)
- Strengthen the enforcement of EU harmonisation legislation on products and deter infringements
- Composed of representatives from each EU Member State, Administrative Coordination Groups (ADCOs) and Commission
- **Coordinates** ADCOs and their activities including exchange of expertise, best practices, information campaigns and development of guidance.



ICSMS tool



- ICSMS is Information and Communication System for Market Surveillance Authorities
- Enables exchange information on <u>market surveillance</u> measures quickly and efficiently
- coordinate activities and inspections more effectively
- share resources and test products which have yet to be tested
- carry out wide-scale market interventions on dubious products using the latest information to avoid duplicate inspections
- develop best practices
- ensure that <u>market surveillance</u> is **efficient and uniform** across all EU countries to prevent the distortion of competition

- Electronic monitoring tool first launched in April 2022 latest update March 2025
- Automatically detects online offers of dangerous products signalled in safety gate
- Provides a list of providers which help Market Surveillance authorities to remove from sale
- HSA participated in latest user testing of WebCrawler

 - Car fragrances





Gold Round decor ring - Safety Alert



The Health and Safety Authority have found the below product available on the Irish market.

Product Description

The product is a gold-coloured ring with a round-shaped decoration sold online.



Risk Description

The product has excessive concentration of cadmium (measured value: 87%). Cadmium is harmful to health. It accumulates in the body, can damage the kidneys and bones and cause cancer. The product does not comply with the REACH Regulation.


