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INFORMATION NOTE

To each importer of certain foods of non-animal origin (FNAO) from certain third countries subject to Import Control Implementing Regulation (EU) 2026/1206, which amends Implementing Regulation 2019/1793 with respect to residues of pesticides

See attached amended Annexes 1 and 2 for list of commodities subject to **Import Controls with effect from 30th of June 2026** which are regulated by the Department of Agriculture, Food and Marine (DAFM).

It is mandatory to declare and process documents for the importation of certain food of non-animal origin (FNAO) using an on-line system, TRACES NT.

- In order to use TRACES NT, importers/agents must first create an EU login at <https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/tracesnt/login> by selecting the link 'Request an access' - <https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/cas/eim/external/register.cgi>
- Once an EU login has been created, the importer/agent applies for a TRACES NT account.
- Within TRACES NT, the importer/agent creates a CHED-D (Common Health Entry Document).
- All documentation required to accompany each consignment must be submitted to the [DAFM Importer Portal](#) at least 24 hours prior to the estimated date of arrival.
- Consignments cannot be released by Customs until DAFM officials have carried out the required checks.

All consignments of FNAO subject to (EU) Import Controls Regulations 2026/1206 for pesticide residues must be imported through:

- 1 Dublin Airport – (Identification of Border Control Post = BCP/IEDUB4-PCD)**
- 2 Dublin Port – (Identification of Border Control Post = BCP/IEDUB1-PCD)**
- 3 Rosslare Port – (Identification of Border Control Post = BCP/IEROS1-PCD)**

Annex I of Regulation 2026/1206: Consignments of these commodities shall be accompanied by appropriate documentation viz.:

- **Single Administrative Document (SAD);**
- **Airway Bill/Bill of Lading (not required for Roll on-Roll off consignments);**
- **Invoice;**
- **Phytosanitary Certificate (where relevant);**
- **EU Movement Cert (where relevant).**

Annex II of Regulation 2026/1206: Consignments of these commodities shall be accompanied by documentation listed above and must also present copies of:

- **Health Certificate**
- **Results of pesticide residues analyses**

Reminder: Annex II (a) of Regulation 2020/625: Entry of foodstuffs consisting of dried beans from Nigeria into EU has been suspended due to continued presence of dichlorvos. This remains in force.

All other commodities subject to Import Control set out in Implementing Regulation 2026/1206, amending Implementing Regulation 2019/1793 (which are not listed here) are controlled by the Feedstuffs, Fertilisers, Grain and Poultry Division of the DAFM (feedimports@agriculture.gov.ie) and/or the Health Service Executive (HSE Port Health - importcontroldublin@hse.ie).

Examination (**sampling and analysis**) will be carried out on selected consignments.

Frequency of sampling and analysis is indicated in Annex I and II.
