Note this approval does not cover the following lettuce types: Scarole (broad leaf endive) wild or red chicory, radicchio, curly leaf endive (frizze) & sugar loaf (Sucre de pain)

Perennial herbs {Agastache spp: angelica, balm, bay, burnet (salad), catnip, chamomile, chives, clary sage, dragonhead, fennel, horehound, hyssop, land cress, lavandin, lavender, lemon verbena, lovage, marjoram, mint, nettle, oregano}, { Origanum heracleoticum spp: plantain, rosemary, rue, sage, sorrel, spike, lavender, St john's Wort, tarragon, thyme, woodruff, yarrow} **Annual herbs** {basil, Borage, caraway, chervil, coriander, curry plant, dill, fenugreek, feverfew, marigold, nasturtium, parsley, rocket (salad), savory, violet}

Other specific restrictions:

Advisory information:

This approval relates to the use of Paraat as an agricultural fungicide for use on the crops and situations listed above.

Applications should be applied protectantly or at the first signs of disease using a minimum of 200 litres of water per ha.

Growers are advised to test a small area of the crop first to ensure the application will not cause damage to the crop especially if the crop is under any stress.

Resistance Management:

In order to minimise risk of resistance:

"Paraat" containing *Dimethomorph* is a multi site target fungicide & is FRAC code 40. Paraat should be used just before infection or at the first sign of infection.

To reduce resistance development Paraat should be applied with products with different modes of action on crops where they are approved.

Do not use consecutive applications of "Paraat". Apply in alternation with fungicides from a different cross resistance FRAC code with satisfactory efficacy against the targeted diseases.

NB Where "Revus" *Mandipropamid* is authorised on any of the above crops it should be noted it too is FRAC code 40 & the possibility of cross-resistance with *Dimethomorph* exists.
