Other specific restrictions:

- (1) To avoid risks to human health & the environment comply with the terms of this approval in conjunction with the directions for use on the product label.
- (2) For any individual crop the maximum total dose refers to the total dose of any product containing the same active ingredient.
- (3) Application by tractor mounted/trailed horizontal boom sprayer only.
- (4) Post application, do not allow unprotected persons to enter treated areas until the crop is completely dry & has been well ventilated.
- (5) For environmental information refer to the product label but specifically: To protect aquatic organisms respect an unsprayed buffer zone of 5m to surface water bodies from tractor mounted/trailed sprayers. Aim spray away from water. Growers may be eligible to reduce the buffer zone under the PRCD STRIPE Scheme.
- (6) This approval extends to professional use only.
- (7) For operator protection refer to the product label in conjunction with the specific restrictions above.

Advisory information:

This approval relates to the use of Zorvec Entecta as a horticultural fungicide for the control of downy mildew (*Peronospora destructor*)

Apply Zorvec Entecta as part of a protectant programme, from 3rd leaf fully visible stage (BBCH 13) until leaves dead, bulb top dry; dormancy Growth complete (BBCH 49). Apply in 200 to 1500 litres water/ha.

Resistance Management:

Total reliance on one pesticide will hasten the development of resistance. This product should be used in conjunction with other fungicides from different cross-resistant groups [different mode of action, FRAC group] with satisfactory efficacy against the target.

Zorvec Entecta contains oxathiapiprolin and amisulbrom Oxathiapiprolin is classed FRAC group F9 Amisulbrom is classed within the FRAC group C4

Zorvec Entecta should be used preventatively and should not be relied on for its curative potential.
